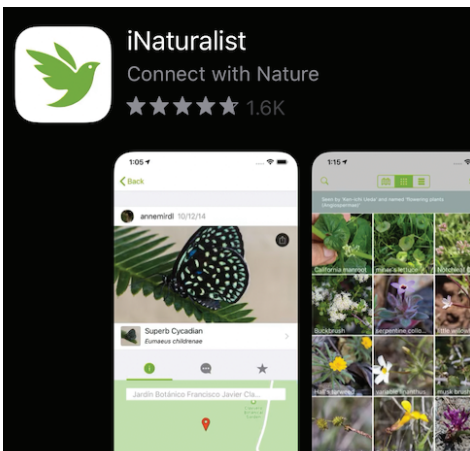


STEP ONE
